Our Spanish Tutoring Program introduces students in grades K–2 to basic Spanish vocabulary and conversational skills in a fun and engaging environment. Students will be introduced to colors, numbers, greetings, common phrases, days of the week, simple directions, and everyday vocabulary through songs, games, stories, and interactive activities, which may include the computer. Lessons are designed to build confidence, listening skills, communication, and cultural awareness while making learning enjoyable and meaningful.

Learning a second language at an early age also strengthens gifted and talented skills by encouraging higher-order thinking, creativity, memory development, problem-solving, and flexible thinking. Spanish instruction helps students become stronger communicators while expanding their curiosity and understanding of the world around them.
